The Sutton Center art display will be changed occasionally during the year. Dates of the changes will be announced at the monthly meetings and published in the newsletter. Items may be brought to the Monday meeting of said months for consideration or by appointment with the committee. Art may be labeled Private Collection or "Not For Sale" if not meant to be sold, or priced for sale.

Please use a felt pen and write legibly on the information cards/labels \*\* which are to be attached to the art, and indicate if the art is your original! The buyer may phone artist directly. If artist is not reached, Common Grounds Coffee Shop will handle the sale for @ 10% commission. The remaining amount will go to the committee chairman who will in turn give it to the artist.
