Directions to the park are below.

Directions from Sandusky to Norwalk Veterans Memorial Lake Park (Reservoir)

*From Sandusky, OH take US 250 South to Norwalk, OH
(If you are driving from OH-2 get off at the Sandusky 250 Exit)

*You stay on US 250 South all the way to Norwalk. (NO TURNING)

(It's about 12 miles from the 250 exit from OH-2 to Norwalk)

*Once in Norwalk you will pass a Bob Evans.

There are several traffic lights and you Keep Going Straight (NO TURNING)

Order of Traffic Lights going South.

1st Light - Burger King (Keep going straight)

2nd Light - KFC (Keep going straight)

3rd Light - CVS Pharmacy (Do Not Turn Right) Keep going straight)

4th Light - Norwalk Catholic School St. Paul (Keep going straight)

***Once you go through that 4th light, you will be on Woodlawn Ave.**

You will stay on Woodlawn Ave for about 1 mile from which you will pass a cemetery

***At the Stop Sign (water tower) - Turn Right onto Old State Rd South**

(after you turn go straight, the **main entrance** to the Park is at the top of the hill on the left for **Shelter 1**)

If you are going to **Shelter 4**, do not turn left at the main entrance. Keep going straight past the reservoir and **turn left at the 2nd entrance at the water tower.** (There is a small Seventh Day Adventist Church on the right)

When you turn left at this water tower just follow the paved lane and just past the sharp curve Shelter 4 is on the left.

Here is an easy way to figure it out. Once you enter Norwalk, you go through 4 traffic lights (no turns) and arrive at 1 stop sign and turn right.
