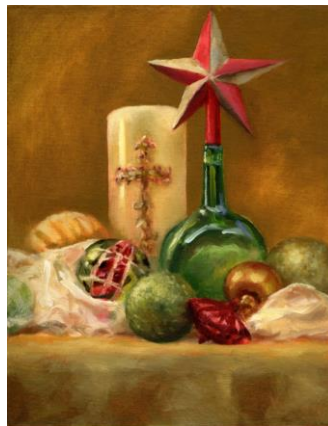
You will need:

Soft Pastels (Jack Richeson, Rembrandt, Unison, Dakota)
Hard Pastels (Nupastels)
Pastel pencils (Derwent, Bruvnzeel)
Pastel paper (Art Spectrum, Canson Mi-Tientes, Uart, PastelMat – all medium grade)
Paper towels
Hand Wipes
Pencil/eraser
Stumps/blending tools
Small table easel

Your own photo reference taken by you! 5x7 inch or larger

Thoughts are birds, wreaths, winter landscape, poinsettia flowers, shiny Christmas ornaments.
Be creative!! Print your photo into at least a 5x7 size photo or larger.
(It's not a good idea to work from your small phone screen.)
